The Lancaster County Corvette Club, Inc. (LCCC) was organized in November 1978, has continued to grow and expand through the "All American Sports Car". The purpose of the LCCC is to encourage the preservation, ownership, and operation of Corvettes. The club's responsibilities are to provide and regulate events and exhibitions for its members, to encourage careful and skillful driving on public highways, to promote good fellowship and cooperation among its members through a common bond, "THE CORVETTE".

The LCCC is affiliated with the National Council of Corvette Clubs, Inc. The NCCC is comprised of nearly 300 clubs and over 10,000 Corvette owners. The local clubs and the National Council as a group give regular support to various charities. Benefits to our club from the NCCC include; a rule book, a regularly published magazine "Blue Bars", and a national convention held each year in a different part of the country.

The LCCC is sponsored by FAULKNER CHEVROLET, of Lancaster, Pa. Mr. Terry Longmore, General Manager, offers club discounts on Corvette parts to our membership. The LCCC activities include recreational and social functions, parades, competition and philanthropic events. Competition events include the following:

CONCOURS: A Concours is nothing more than a beauty pageant for Corvettes. The participating Corvettes are grouped in a predetermined NCCC class which takes into consideration the make, model, style, and age. Cars participating must meet certain standards to qualify. Our club usually holds at least two course a year, usually in June and October.

AUTOCROSS: This is also known as a gymkhana. It is a closed circuit where the competing drivers can take as many minutes as they wish to execute their driving skills. The course, which is set up with pylons, may be held in a parking lot, on a closed strip of pavement or a road course. Cars are classed depending on engine size or modifications, and year. LCCC holds four or five autocrosses yearly.

DRAGS: Drag racing is either by time or wheel to wheel competition on an eighth or quarter mile drag strip. Matching time trials may be run in drag racing. LCCC participates in other clubs drag racing events.

RALLYE: Rallying can be classified into two main types: time and distance events and fun rallies. In each type there is some trick or puzzle to be solved. The rallye demands a team of two, one driver and the other to navigate. LCCC rallies are usually fun rallies.

FUNKHANA: Similar to an autocross, only that a navigator is in the car along with the driver for the purpose of gimmicks to be performed along the course. Sometimes the driver may be blindfolded. All in fun!
