The story of my 2008 Corvette begins after a 25 year lapse in ownership, having owned 5 Corvettes from 1969 through 1982.

After my wife passed on in May of 2007, life as I knew it was changed forever. That fall her brother & family invited me & my daughter to spend a weekend with their family in Rehoboth DE. One of the activities they wanted to do was to visit the Boardwalk in Ocean City, MD.

As we arrived there I noticed Corvettes everywhere & by the time we reached the Inlet parking lot, at least 3 of the 4 cars there were Corvettes! This rekindled my interest in Corvettes & I spent the afternoon looking at cars, talking with owners & feeling like a kid in a candy store.

This set my mind to thinking about owning one again & after months of checking out the possibilities including online research about the car & all the changes & improvements which were made since my '79, I decided to order a new Z06 ! Part of the reason for this decision was to include a buyer tour of the plant to see it being built & also participate in the Museum delivery program, then drive it home !!

On April 22, 2008 my 3 daughters & I traveled to Bowling Green KY to tour the Corvette plant & to see my car for the first time on the assembly line! At the point where the computer software is loaded into the car's computer I was able to sit in the passenger seat during this process & then hit the start button at which time the attendant told me "this is the first time this engine has been run in this car".

At the end of the assembly line I was able to sit in the drivers seat & start the car again after which I was presented with a Birth Certificate on which I wrote the date & VIN for the car along with my name.

As you might imagine, I was in a daze & my mind was spinning as I tried to comprehend what all of this meant.

On May 14, my son, son in law & then 17 year old grandson visited Bowling Green to tour the Corvette plant & Corvette Museum after which I took delivery of the car, purchased a Lifetime Membership to the Museum & then my son & I began the 736 mile trip home!

My son later told me "this car will never leave the family"!

This Corvette has brought me many delights including my membership in the Lancaster County Corvette Club, learning to know the members & participating in the various Club activities !

The story of my 2004 convertible begins on May 19, 2021 when I was privileged to purchase the 2004 convertible from Club members Mark & Nancy Hackman ! Mark was a meticulous owner & the car had only 38,925 miles on it at that time.

My main goal in purchasing this car was to enjoy convertible rides & to participate in parades with our Club members.

I purchased the Corvette pedal car in 2000 as a token of my love for Corvettes, so I was glad to find a "big brother" for it !



No open exhaust systems are allowed for this event (a street legal exhaust system is required). All drivers and passengers must wear either a Snell SA2015 or M2015 or must have a manufacture date less than ten years old and closed toe shoes. The helmet date limit for this event is: May 22, 2013. All cars will undergo a technical inspection to assure that there are no fluid leaks or plainly visible safety issues. Those with mobility issues will be allowed to use an unpowered mobility vehicle to "walk" the course.

Passengers are allowed in vehicles ONLY with the event chairperson's permission. If they are not participating in the event and are age 12 or older. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parental form completed and signed at time of participation. If someone violates safety rules they may be expelled from the event. They may not compete in further events, and they would not get a refund.

Electric vehicles are not allowed to participate due to the required special fire safety requirements that are not available at the event. This is a NCCC requirement.


