
Having a successful show and auction will require a lot of help. Plan to help make this a great day!



All drivers and passengers must wear either a Snell SA2015 or M2015 or must have a manufacture date less than ten years old and closed toe shoes. The helmet date limit for this event is: September 18, 2013. All cars will undergo a technical inspection to assure that there are no fluid leaks or plainly visible safety issues. Those with mobility issues will be allowed to use an unpowered mobility vehicle to "walk" the course.

Passengers are allowed in vehicles ONLY with the event chairperson's permission. If they are not participating in the event and are age 12 or older. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parental form completed and signed at time of participation. If someone violates safety rules they may be expelled from the event. They may not compete in further events, and they would not get a refund.

Electric vehicles are not allowed to participate due to the required special fire safety requirements that are not available at the event. This is a NCCC requirement.





All drivers and passengers must wear either a Snell SA2015 or M2015 or must have a manufacture date less than ten years old and closed toe shoes. The helmet date limit for this event is: October 2, 2013. All cars will undergo a technical inspection to assure that there are no fluid leaks or plainly visible safety issues. Those with mobility issues will be allowed to use an unpowered mobility vehicle to "walk" the course.

Passengers are allowed in vehicles ONLY with the event chairperson's permission. if they are not participating in the event and are age 12 or older. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parental form completed and signed at time of participation. If someone violates safety rules they may be expelled from the event.
