Treasurer's Report

In Carl's absence Kurt asked if there were questions or corrections to the Treasurer's Report as presented in the Members' Only section of the Club website. Motion was made to accept by Betty Marley, seconded by Marv Fox. All in favor, motion passed.

Governor's Report-Clyde Mooney

The first Governor's Meeting for 2023 was held via Zoom on Saturday, March 11th. From LCCC, Scott Breneman, Valerie Cifuni, Scott and Mary Anne Lewandowski, and I were in attendance. The meeting was opened with the playing of the National Anthem followed by an attendance roll call.

After the roll call, I had the pleasure of introducing the new East Region-National Corvette Museum Ambassadors, our own Scott and Mary Anne. I would like to say "Thank You" to them for volunteering to fill the position.

Michele Cantelmo, Secretary reviewed the minutes from the prior meeting and Valerie Cifuni, Treasurer presented the treasurer's report and budget. As there were no questions or comments, motions were made to approve both as presented and both were passed.

Steve Johnson, NCCC Vice-President Membership had sent a status report covering membership. Current NCCC membership is 17,651 with 234 clubs. The East Region has 1,908 members with 24 clubs. Cumberland Valley Corvette Club is the largest club in our region with 216 members, while LCCC with 119 members currently ranks seventh.

Andrej Blanc, East Region Competition Director emphasized the need to put on all flyers that Electric Vehicles including Hybrids and not allowed in any events covered by the Competition Rulebook. EV's are allowed to attend non-competition club events. Also, the statement "Non-NCCC members are not covered under NCCC insurance" must be on all flyers.

The next Governor's Meeting will be held at the Holiday Inn, Grantville, PA on May 20th. In conjunction with the meeting, the East Region will be holding a seven sanction People's Choice Car Show. The cost to enter a single sanction event is

only \$5.00. The flyer with complete details and entry form can be found on the East Region website www.ernccc.org. Please consider attending. It is only about an hour's drive, registration opens at 8;00 AM, with awards at noon. This is our regions only fund raiser for 2023 and I would encourage you to attend.

Here is our "Thanks to our Sponsors" picture for 2022. I would also like to thank the many members of the Lancaster County Corvette Club for their donations and remind all, there is still time to



donate. I am on the right and Gary "Duck" Drake, my Transit Driver is on the left. We will be using my 2008 Blue Z51 Corvette again this year.

I am getting ready for this year's event in which we will compete in early May. Every year we do a different route, this year we will be traveling from South Bend to Grissom Air Force base then to Nelson Ledges in eastern Ohio, then off to Atlanta. After Atlanta, we will head to the Nashville Superspeedway Roval. After two road course events at Nashville, that afternoon we have another long transit to Eagles Canyon Raceway in Texas, after two events there we have a short drive to the Drag Strip for two drag events then that evening we drive to Oklahoma to Hallett Motor Raceway. After Hallett we have another long drive to the National Corvette Museum Racetrack in Bowling Green, Kentucky, and then back to South Bend, Indiana. The event will be about 3400 miles. With the miles to South Bend and back home, the total will be almost 4,800 miles in about 9 days.

Gary "Duck" Drake from Hamilton, Ohio will again be my Transit Driver, helping with the highway miles, and I will do all the competition driving. As for the museum, your TPIR Gamemeister has toured this amazing compilation of Corvettes and other rare classic vehicles multiple times (pretty much whenever a visitor has come to visit Kelly and me in north Texas) and has been blownaway each and every time! The recent passing of Pete Horton, who amassed this incredible collection with his wife Barbara, is what precipitated this liquidation.

This sale will feature 40 Corvettes, almost all of them C1's, C2's, and C3's (The Horton Museum had at least one of each year from 1953-1973, including FOUR '63 Split Windows – one of them a ZO6!), along with another 77 premium examples of the best vehicles the automotive world had to offer throughout the years. 




