

- Bart Hollis reported that we currently have 109 members. He has sent the updated Membership list to John Sauder.


## Newsletter:

## **1968 Chevrolet Corvette. The car that talks back**

The 1968 Chevrolet Corvette advertisement, titled "The car that talks back," was a vintage print ad that celebrated the Stingray's innovation and driver-focused engineering. The ad featured a headline that highlighted the Corvette's ability to connect man and machine through performance and precision. It included features such as the new fiber-optic monitoring system, rally clock, and instrument panel packed with gauges, making it a perfect collectible for Corvette enthusiasts. The ad was a significant piece of automotive advertising from the late 1960s, showcasing the technical sophistication and boldness of the era.

## Driven to Preserve Telling the Story of Corvette Preservation



**Driven to Preserve** is rooted in the mission of the National Corvette Museum: to collect, preserve, and share the legacy of America's Sports Car. This limited-engagement exhibition

shifts the focus from showroom shine to the real work of stewardship. Inside the gallery, visitors experience how Corvettes are tracked, documented, stabilized, and interpreted—not

just displayed. Every process serves one purpose: protecting both the vehicle and the story

it carries.

As the Museum prepares for the opening of a new 66,000-square-foot Collections Facility, **Driven to Preserve** introduces the expanded vision behind that investment. This is preservation in motion, revealed for the first time.

### **Preservation in Practice**

See how vehicles are documented, moved, and cared for using museum-grade standards.

### **Iconic Corvettes**

See a variety of rare and historic Corvettes that highlight preservation and restoration efforts.

### **The Story Behind the Fiberglass**

Preservation protects context, modifications, materials, and history, not just the car.

### **What You'll See Inside the Gallery**

Inside the Limited Engagement Gallery, Corvettes are presented as working collection objects. Vehicles are arranged on lifts, with interpretive displays explaining how Museum staff manage everything from environmental monitoring to object tracking.

This approach allows the Museum to continue active preservation work while giving visitors

direct access to the process. It's transparency by design, and it reflects a belief that stewardship should be visible.


